## Overview

---

The following five priority areas, structured across short-, medium-, and long-term horizons, provide a coherent roadmap toward energy justice. What to do: Introduce risk-sharing guarantees, targeted tax incentives, and innovative financing tools (green bonds, blended finance). The region faces pressing challenges, including energy poverty, limited electricity access, and the need for a just and sustainable energy transition. In addition, financial challenges pose a significant obstacle to the energy transition, especially in the provision of affordable and reliable. In 2023, access to electricity was estimated at just 56.7%, far below the sub-Saharan African average of 72%. The Energy Transition Strategy and Action Plan (ETSAP) is a continental framework developed by the African Energy Commission of the African Union as a guiding framework for Africa's transition to a sustainable, low-carbon energy future by 2063. The latest report, released on Friday, forms part of the IRENA series, Planning and Prospects for Renewable Energy, that focuses on renewable electricity generation in African power pools.

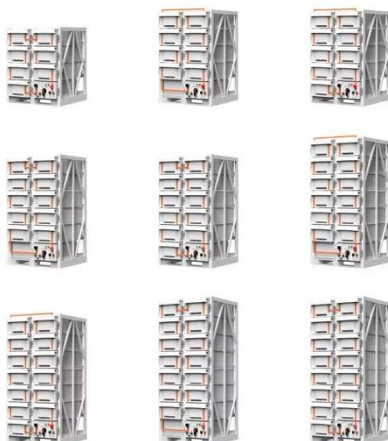
