The Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC) of Thailand is poised to implement a reduction of 0. Anchored in the Thirteenth National Economic and Social Development Plan and aligned with the global Agenda. On J, the National Energy Policy Council (NEPC) approved a pilot policy intending to enable data centers to directly procure renewable energy through Direct Power Purchase Agreements (Direct PPAs), facilitated by Third Party Access (TPA) through the national grid for up to 2,000 MW.
