A correct medicine storage temperature chart and pharmaceutical cold-storage requirements and equipment indicate that some antibiotics, injectables, and controlled drugs should be stored in special refrigeration systems, not in standard fridges. For the pharmaceutical sector, proper storage is not. This can happen when driving in a cold car, keeping medicine in an unheated place, or mailing prescriptions without proper care.

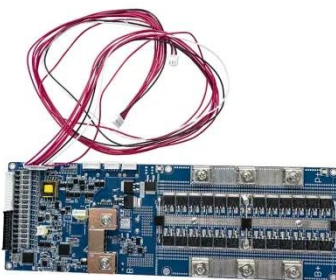
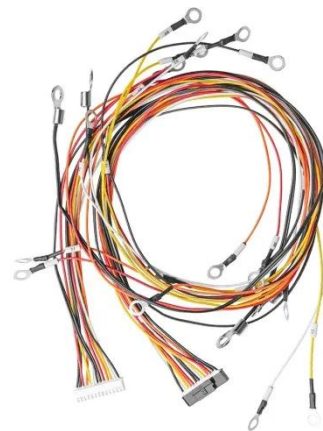
