Overview

1) Structure: A typical single glass panel has a front layer of tempered glass, followed by an encapsulant material (usually EVA - Ethylene Vinyl Acetate), then the solar cells, another. As the first layer of materials in the solar module structure, tempered glass can effectively protect the panel and solar cells against physical stress, snow, wind, dust and moisture etc, at the same time guaranteeing that the sunlight can go in. The backside is generally protected by an opaque.

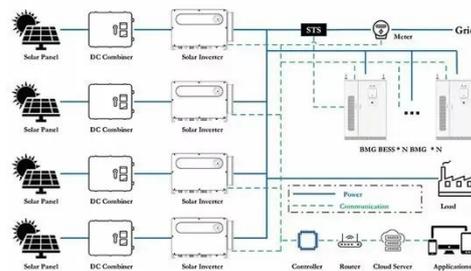
