This means that while you'll still have your system up and running after 30 years, it won't be operating at its best possible production, instead producing around. Modern solar panels are built to last 25–30 years with minimal maintenance. However, their actual replacement timeline depends on several factors, including natural degradation rates that slowly reduce efficiency, exposure to harsh environmental conditions like hail or extreme heat, and the overall.

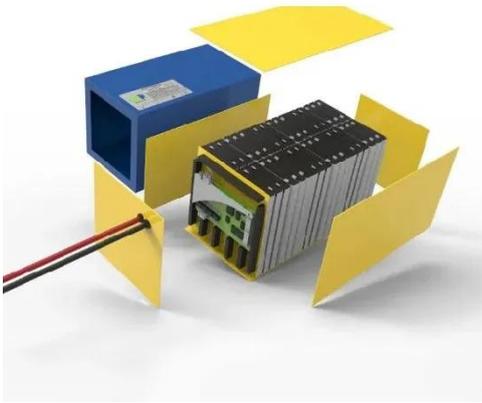


