Or say you'll never have to pay another electricity bill because government programs, grants, or rebates cover your solar installation?

It's likely a scam. The criminals are leaving unsuspecting homeowners with massive debt; many victims have reported losing tens of thousands of dollars.

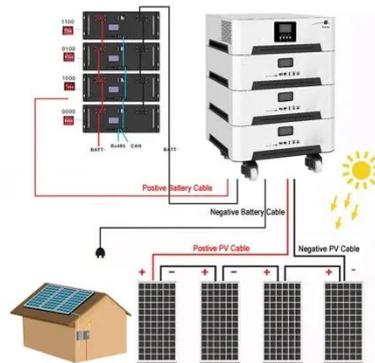
