The Assessment Law Committee (ALC) of the Assessors' Association of Pennsylvania (AAP) has been working since early 2021 to develop a uniform approach to taxation of grid-scale solar (GSS) projects. Below we summarize that committee's approach to valuation. This is informed by their interpretation. The owner of a qualified solar facility may claim the investment tax credit (“ITC”). The ITC is a one-time credit against income tax that is based on the amount invested in a facility (rather than on the amount of electricity produced and sold).
