Overview

The development process for a utility scale solar power plant can vary depending on a number of factors, such as the size and complexity of the project, local regulations and permitting requirements, but typically includes the stages shown here in this infographic. 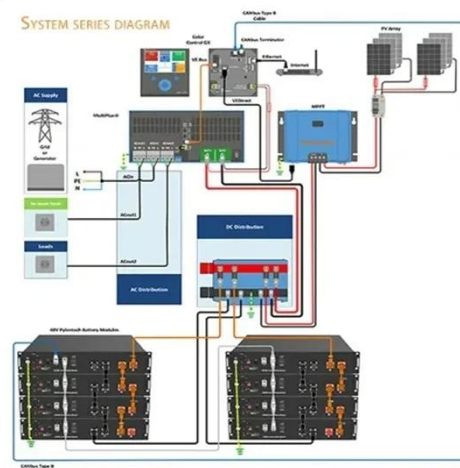
