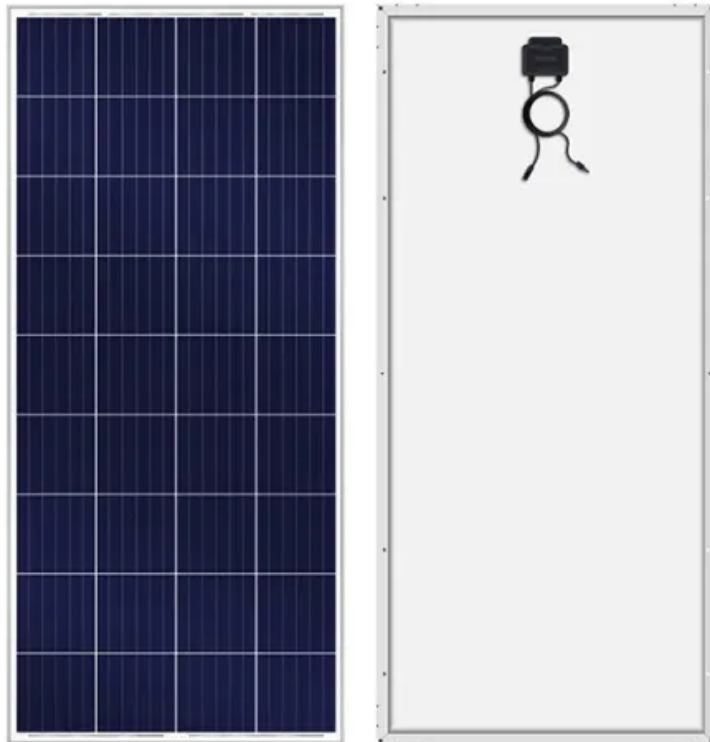


Terrace solar power generation record



Overview

The latest record is the 17th of 2025, an astounding 7,785 megawatts (MW) higher than the first record of 22,092 MW set Jan. Solar set a new ERCOT record (last Tuesday) on Sept. 9, generating almost half of total demand in the fast-growing Texas electricity market while providing more than 40% of the state's electricity for seven straight hours, from 9 a. ERCOT avoided conservation alerts for first summer since Winter Storm Uri. Texas hit a major renewable energy milestone during summer 2025.
