

# Vatican solar Communication Base Station EMS



## Overview

ROME (AP) — Pope Francis decreed Wednesday that an area of northern Rome, long the source of controversy because of electromagnetic waves emitted by Vatican Radio towers there, will now house a field of solar panels to fuel Vatican City. Pope Leo XIV visited the Vatican's radio transmitter station in Santa Maria di Galeria, Italy, on Thursday and thanked staff for their dedicated work in communicating the Church's mission around the world. During the June 19 site visit, the Holy Father blessed staff working in the central radio. Today's feast of the Body and Blood of Christ is a Vatican holiday, although Pope Leo will celebrate the Mass and Corpus Christi procession on Sunday when the feast is observed in Italy. The pope took the day to visit a huge Vatican property outside Rome.


