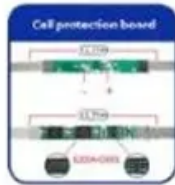


When will solar power be refunded

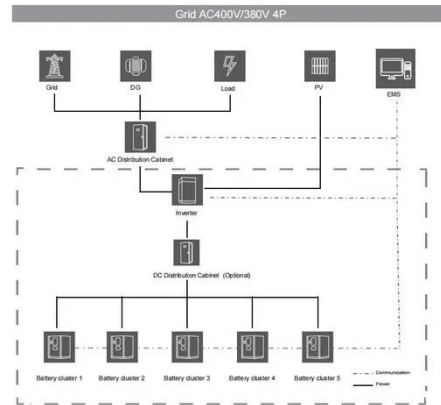
